

Instructions for Cat Trespass Complaint Form

This is an editable PDF form. You may type directly into the form or print it out and fill it out by hand.

Complainant(s):

Complainant(s) must fill out the form completely and then print out and sign the form. If there are additional complainants (optional), they may add their contact information under the "Additional Complainant" section.

Incident Date and Time:

List a specific date and time that the cat(s) was trespassing on your property. Take a photo of the offending cat trespassing and attach it to this form. A photo *MUST* be attached in order to process the complaint. If possible, use a time/date stamp. If not, please write a date and time on the back of the photo. (Please note: the photo will not be returned)

Owner of Animal

In order to process a complaint, we must have owner contact information for the animal(s).

Description of Animal

Please be as complete as possible. Attach additional sheets if needed.

Notice to Complainant(s):

Complainant(s) listed on this form must be willing to appear at a hearing or this incident could be dismissed.
