In order to establish a service animal's function and training, and in accordance with the Multnomah County Code, individuals requesting a license fee waiver must provide Multnomah County Animal Services with both:

- Certification of Function and Training (below)
- Pet License Application (printable version at MultCoPets.org)

Multnomah County Code 13.103 states that:

License fees shall be waived for any **dog** used primarily as a service animal upon the owner or keep establishing the service animal's function as an assistance animal under the Americans with Disabilities Act, 42 USC 12101 et seq.

The Americans with Disabilities Act defines a "service animal" as any dog individually trained to provide assistance to an individual with a qualified disability. Service animals perform functions and tasks that the individual with a disability cannot perform for him or herself.
